ELIGIBILITY

Educators affiliated with a K-12, university, or informal institution, who are currently teaching or developing education programs in the field of biomimicry, or plan to develop and teach a biomimicry module or course within one year of attendance at the 2013 Biomimicry Education Summit.

REQUIREMENTS

- Demonstrated interest and knowledge of biomimicry concepts and tools.
- Demonstrated experience teaching and/or developing curricula (graduate teaching assistantships qualify).
- Following the Summit, please share with us any curricula developed as a result of attending. Approved curricula will be posted for other educators to access on the Biomimicry Education Network website operated by the Biomimicry 3.8 Institute at <http://ben.biomimicry.net>

HOW TO APPLY

Please prepare the following:

- Brief résumé including full name and contact information.
- List of relevant courses taught, teaching, or planned.
- One-page statement of your interest and involvement in the field of biomimicry, which incorporates your plan to develop and teach at least one biomimicry course offering at your affiliated institution within one year of attendance at the Education Summit.
- Description of your expected outcomes from attending the 2013 Summit.
